All adults who work with or around children are required to complete background screening and attend a Virtus "Protecting God's Children" Awareness Session within two months of volunteering.

1. The following Volunteer Positions will be assigned on a rotating basis and one can expect to serve at least once a month.

- ____ **Hall Monitor** (1 per class session) Monitor the facility and classrooms to ensure the safety of the children and compliance with Safe Environment regulations.
- ____ **Nursery Workers** (2 per class session) Care for volunteers' children during class time.
- ____ **Substitute Catechists** Fill in, as a Catechist on an as needed basis.
- ____ **Door Monitors** (2 per class session) Monitor the doors coming into the Parish Center to ensure the safety of the children and compliance with Safe Environment regulations.
- ____ **Bathroom Monitors** (1 per class session) Monitor the bathrooms in the Parish Center Lobby to ensure the safety of the children and compliance with Safe Environment regulations.

2. The following Volunteer Positions will require assistance approximately 5 times a year.

- ____ **Hospitality/Special Activities Team** (15 adults needed) Assist with the details of and staff Sacramental Receptions, Retreats, Special Activities and other Activities as needed.
- ____ **Service Project Team**: Two adults needed to help coordinate the Youth Service Project program.

3. The following Volunteer Position in addition to the background screening and Protecting God's Children Awareness Session require one to be a fully initiated Catholic in good Standing and participation in Catechist Formation (Workshops, training, planning, and Pathways).

- ____ **Lead Catechists** (One per class) Prepare and present lessons to assigned grade level with help of assigned Catechist.
- ____ **Catechists** (One per class) Work with Lead Catechist in preparing and presenting lessons to assigned grade level.

4. "Come to the TABLE" - Whole Community Catechesis

- ____ **Committee Member and Volunteer** will work with a committee at meetings to plan activities and food for Come to the TABLE events as well as help the day of the event.
- ____ **Breakout leader** will lead activities or lessons during the breakout times for "Come to the TABLE" events for assigned age group.
