► **STOP HUNGER NOW:** "Thank You!" to all of you who donated your time, talent and treasure to fight against hunger and the many health risks and diseases that result from malnutrition. Your generosity raised \$8,742.57 for this program. Since our twin parish in Haiti has room to store only \$6,000 worth of the packaged meals, we will send the remaining packaged foods to the Stop Hunger Now program for their regular distribution to countries with impoverished, underfed and undernourished children and families. Again, I thank you for your Christ-like concern for those less fortunate than we are.

► **Haiti Update:** Thanks to your generosity, St. Ann's sent a check to our twin parish in Haiti for \$3450.00 to cover the costs of the school staff salaries for the months of May and June, 2012 (1,440) and the lunch costs for May and June, 2012 (2,000). An additional \$10 is included to cover the costs of transferring the funds.
